**BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District, Seneca County, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to Sections 30 and 56 of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell not exceeding \$900,000 revenue anticipation notes of the Romulus Central School District, Seneca County, including renewals thereof, in

anticipation of the receipt of State Aid becoming due during the fiscal year of said District commencing July 1, 2009, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner as may be determined by said President of the Board of Education, pursuant to the Local Finance Law.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
