WITNESSETH, that in consideration of the sum of THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) per year and other valuable consideration paid by the party of the second part to the party of the first part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said parties hereto do agree to contract with each other as follows:

- The party of the first part agrees to keep and maintain in the Town of Ovid, New York, during the term hereof, a free public library and thereby make available to all students and teachers of said Romulus Central School District, books for research, reference, history, and education, subject to such rules and regulations as to hours of opening, length of time any such books may be kept or used, and any other rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees and said Society may, from time-to-time, adopt or promulgate.
- The party of the second part agrees to pay to the said party of the first part the sum of THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) annually, by taxes collected by Romulus Central School District for the purpose of the Ovid Edith Ford Library upon presentation to it or its Trustees of a verified claim thereof for audit and payment.
- This Agreement shall be for one year from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
