- Indicate in the Integrated Content Area ex. MST, if your integrated standards are focusing on science you would put an “S” under MST, along with the Standard # and P.I. (use the link to NYS Standards and P.I.)
- Fill in cell with corresponding color code, go Format, Borders and Shading, click “apply to cell”, pick correct color, then “OK”
- Indicate with either an **E**, **I**, **C**, or **A** the level of curriculum (**E**-Elementary, **I**-Intermediate, **C**-Commencement, **A**-Alternate)
