**References Sheet for Proper Citations in Formal Writing and Web design– APA  
Format**

**Use this format if you are citing a source from a book:**

Author's Name. (date of publication). *Title of book*. City: Publisher.

**Use this format if you are citing a source from a Magazine or**

**Journal:**

Author, A. A., Author, B. B., & Author, C. C. (date of publication—or n.d. if no date).

Title of article. *Title of periodical*, volume#, page #s. Retrieved month day, year,  
from source.

**Use this format if you are citing a source from software:**

Author, A. A. Title of article. (date of publication). In *Title of media* [CD-ROM]. City:  
Publisher.

**Use this format if you are citing a source from a personal web**

**page:**

Author, A. A. (date of posting). *Title of work*. Retrieved month day, year, from  
organization name Web site: URL

**Use these two formats if you are citing a source from an**

**organizational web page:**

Organization name [no author]. (date of publication). *Title of work*. Retrieved month day,  
year, from URL

*Title of work* [no author or organization]. (date of publication). Retrieved month day, year, from URL

*Please note: Do exactly what you see! Where there are indentations-indent. Where something is italicized-italicize. Where something is enclosed in parentheses-use parentheses. There is no need to number your sources, however, they need to be in alphabetical order according to the author's last name.*
