John shared the options presented to school superintendents for grading the ELA 4 and 8 assessments. They will be voting later this month.

We discussed possible agenda items for future meetings:

- Share best practices that help us to meet each ELA Standard. We could produce an ELA document K-12 to share among districts.
- How are districts preparing/remediating students? Are there any programs that target students at risk?
- Every meeting we need to take time to share "current" information on state testing so that everyone can have access to the same information.
