

LEGAL/ADVOCACY

Advocacy is an individualized service that provides personal support and practical assistance about any number of issues. It can take many forms-legal assistance, case management or self advocacy training.

LEGAL ASSISTANCE = (LA): Providing legal information, representation or assistance in obtaining needed services, entitlements or dealings with the courts or administrative procedures.

CASE MANAGEMENT = (CM): Process to assist an individual and or family to identify, access and coordinate needed services.

SELF ADVOCACY = (SA): Training for persons with disabilities to achieve greater independence, self-confidence and assertiveness in their lives.
