1. **BOCES CSO Meeting** – I attended the BOCES CSO meeting this Friday anticipating much discussion would occur on the defeat of the Sodus capital project, which was to house the BOCES students at the end of our lease. There was much interest in extending the lease with us. I explained we could not extend it in its present form but the Board had authorized me to explore options with Dr. Marinelli. Some of these options might allow students to remain in the district. The Marion School District also expressed an interest in the BOCES project.
