**Ms. Keel declared the polls open at 12 Noon and Mr. St. Thomas read the Call.
Voters cast ballots for the following Propositions and Board Candidates:**

Proposition No. 1 –

RESOLVED THAT the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District, Seneca County, is hereby authorized to expend a total of \$10,626,612 for the operation of the school of said District for the school year 2013-2014, and that said sum be raised by tax upon taxable property of said School District after first deducting the estimated money available from State Aid and other sources.

Proposition No. 2 –

RESOLVED THAT the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District, Seneca County, is hereby authorized and directed to establish a Capital Reserve Fund – Purchase of Buses for a sum of money not to exceed \$1,700,000 and a probable existence of ten (10) years, for the purchase of school buses used for transportation of District students. The source of funds shall be obtained from the liquidation of the current Bus Purchase Reserve Fund and the current and future unappropriated fund balances as directed by the Board of Education; and

BE IT, FURTHER, RESOLVED THAT the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District authorizes the withdrawal from this Fund of money not to exceed one hundred and twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the purchase of one (1) 66-passenger school bus during the 2013-14 school year.
