Wayne's German students look forward to participating in this exchange during the summer of 2003.

G. A. P. P.

German American Partnership Program

The German American Partnership Program (GAPP) is an academic Student Exchange Program jointly sponsored and subsidized by the German and the American governments. It has been a successful program for the past thirty years. Each year more than 11,000 American and German students participate with their teachers. At present there are over 700 partnerships between American and German secondary schools.

G.A.P.P. is the largest and least expensive exchange program between the U.S. and another country. Both the American and the German governments support the exchange with subsidies for the chaperoning teacher and participating students. The official airline of Germany, Lufthansa, supports the program by offering special rates for participating students and teachers. It has a state-of-the-art fleet that has set new standards of reliability and comfort on long flights.

German teachers accompanying their students are sent to New York for a detailed training conference in October or November and are supported by other professionals experienced in using G.A.P.P.

The heart of this program is the integration of students into the everyday life of the host families and into the classroom activities. Students experience the country as a resident. The integration opens many doors that remain closed to the typical traveler, and adds new aspects to the intercultural understanding between participants and schools. Wayne students attend the Johannes Kepler Gymnasium (high school) in the town of Weil der Stadt, similar in size to Ontario. Weil der Stadt lies between Stuttgart and the Black

Forest. Exchange students go to school, and spend their free time in activities with the host families and members of the community.

With G.A.P.P., a minimum of two weeks of school attendance is mandatory. If travel in Germany is done the third week, it becomes the responsibility of the coordinators and the parents. Students are expected to participate lively in the partner school activities and life of their host family. They are to converse in the language of the host country. They must also be prepared to be hosts to a student from the partner school during the return visit.

As they share ideas with the host school and community and adjust to the different culture, the students gain in self-assurance and sensitivity to others. The process leads as no other process can to the decrease of misconceptions. Daily meetings are held with Wayne students for guidance and orientation. Students learn more from such a stay than ever possible through television, Internet or local school sources. Such experiences may give students a competitive edge now and in the future.

The school lunch program generated a profit of approximately \$9600 for the 2001/2002 school year. The program was able to generate this profit, despite the fact that it was a year in which the district paid retro-active pay for the settlement of the CSEA contract.

At this time, we are estimating the fund balance at year-end in the school lunch fund will be approximately \$74,000. We have a quality school lunch program. I feel that we can maintain that same level of quality at the \$1.60 lunch cost, while keeping the school lunch fund in good financial shape.
