Under Reports to the Board, Trustee Gretchen Craft reported on the next issue of the “What’s Happening” due in early April, and Adam Vitalone reported on a Town Park Meeting he had recently attended. Vice-President William Herbert reported on his recent trip to Mexico and the book he had just completed titled What Really Matters for Struggling Readers.

The Board approved several CSE Cases and was entertained by the Elementary School Musical group. The second was for the purchase of three buses. Both propositions will be discussed further at the next meeting. They would both be funded with reserve funds, and therefore, would not increase the tax rate for residents.
