

Multiplying Polynomials

Use the Distributive Property (works for any multiplication)

Ex) Simplify $3(5z - 6) =$

Ex) Simplify $2x^2y(-3x + 2y - 4) =$

Ex) Simplify $(b^2 + 2b - 1) - 3b(b + 5) =$

Ex) Simplify $(a + 1)(a^2 + 2a + 1) =$

Use FOIL: **Front** **Outer** **Inner** **Last**
(only good for multiplying binomials)

Ex) Simplify $(z + 3)(z + 4)$
Using Distributive Property

Using FOIL

Ex) Simplify $(x + 1)(x + 3)$

Ex) Simplify $(3w + 7)(2w - 5)$
