1. Sketch details of the flower



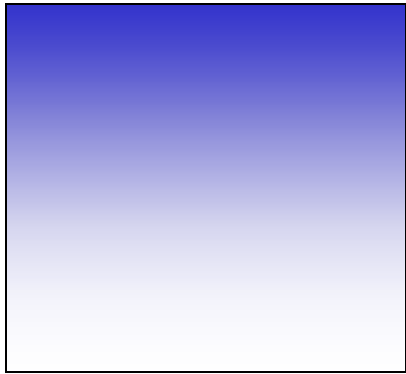
Draw 3 slightly different angles of the same flower

Then Enlarge one of the sketches onto the big sheet of paper

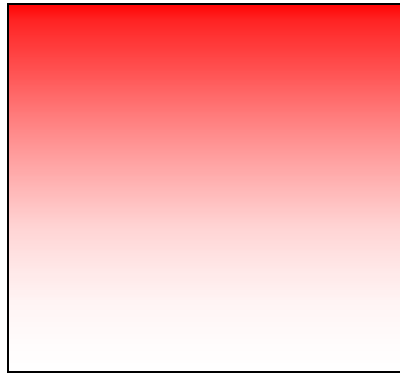


HUE – Use the 3 primary colors to paint the flowers.

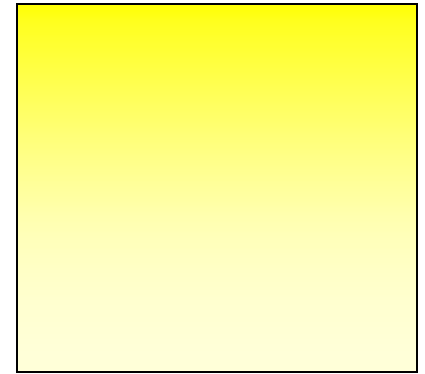
One Color per small sketch

RED



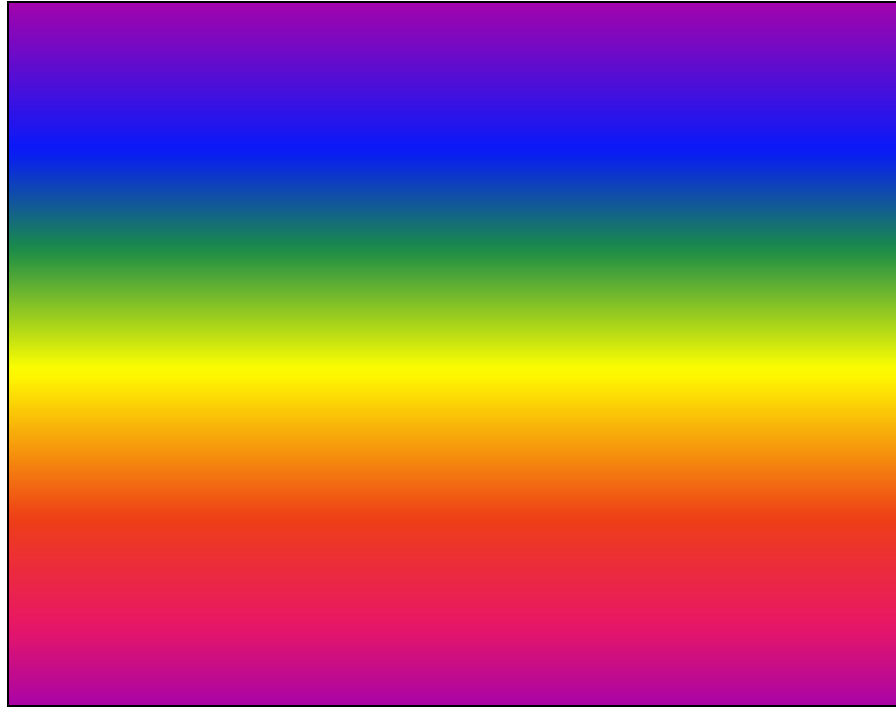
YELLOW
