

Pinhole Photography

To do pinhole, all you really need is a light-tight box. Almost anything can be turned into a camera. All kinds of light-sensitive materials will work. And it's easy to make a pinhole, or pinholes for multiple imaging.

Step 1 – make the inside of the camera black

Step 2 – Making of the aperture

- a. Cut small hole in side of container
- b. Cut a piece of tin foil slightly larger than the hole

poke a small hole into the tin foil

tape the foil over the larger hole on the side of the container

Step 3 - Use tape to make a shutter

Step 4 - Load photo paper in dark room

Step 5 - Develop in the dark room

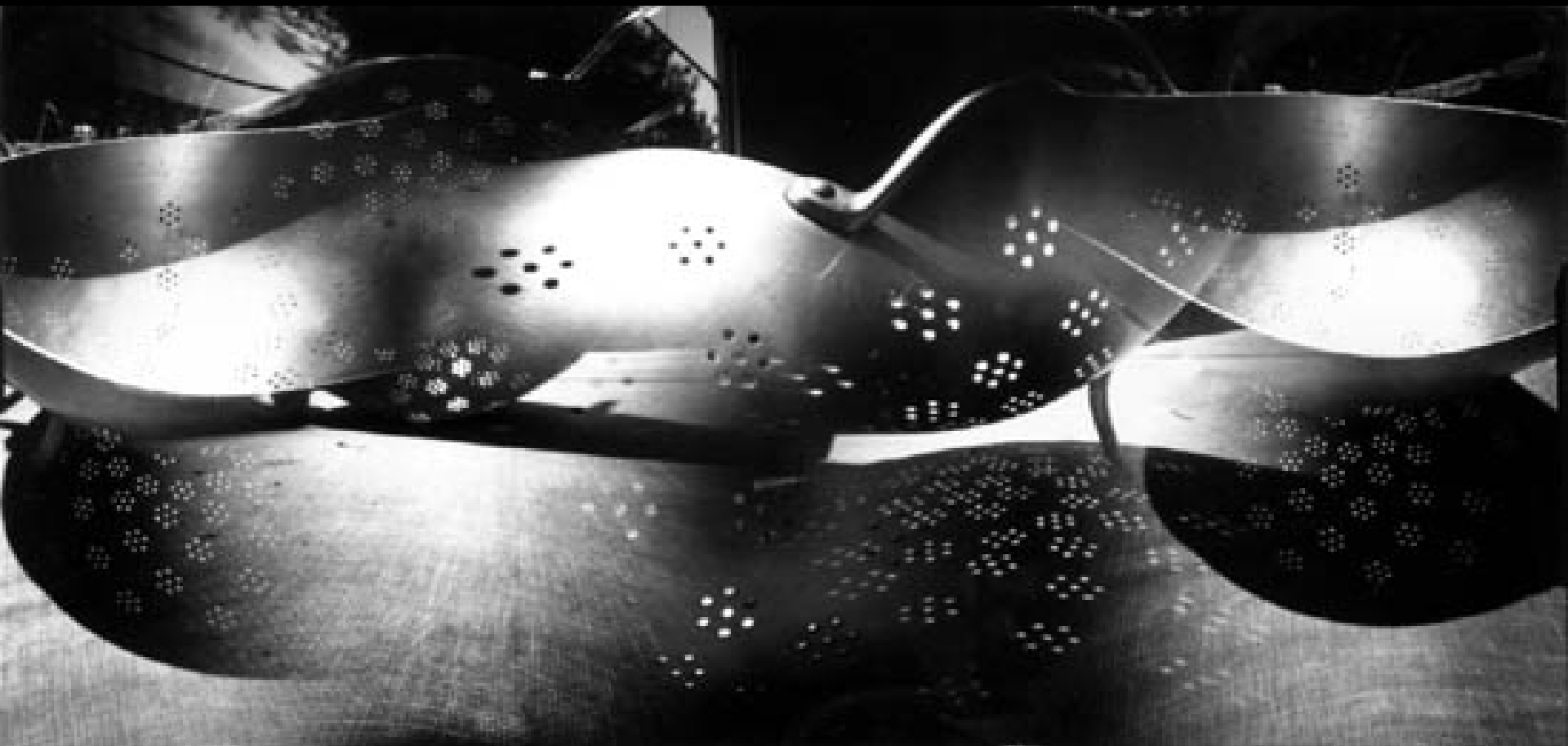
