At last year's Board administrative retreat, we set a goal of 75% success rate for our students with disabilities. It appears that our children reached that goal at every grade level. - 2. Freewill:** This morning we met with representatives of the Town of Walworth to discuss the possibility of a long term lease of the building. They understand that we have not yet committed ourselves to one campus, but they might be interested in the facility should we move to the Ontario Campus. We have agreed to provide them with drawings of the school along with utility usage. We are meeting again in June to continue discussions.
- 3. Superintendent's Hearing:** I believe you will be getting an appeal of a superintendent's hearing that was held this week. I explained that they would need to put their appeal in writing to you. When there is an appeal, each party presents a letter to you explaining their reasoning for either wanting the decision changed or maintained. The parents may not follow through but I didn't want you surprised.
